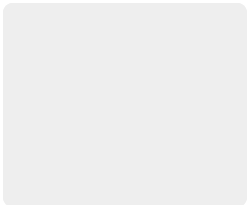

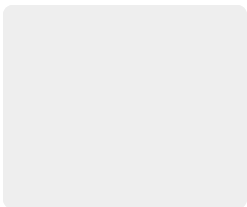

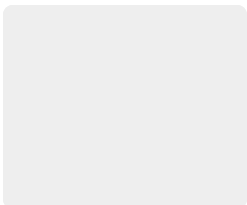






**Photocopy of Laying Cornerstone of Preston City Congregational Church

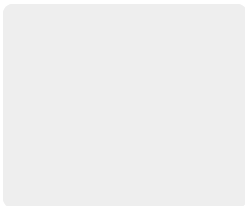
